

The University follows the 'Credit System' for all its programmes, Each Credit entails approximately 30 hours of study comprising of all activities, Thus, a 3-credit course involves 90 study hours, This helps the candidates to understand the academic efforts he/she has to put in suitably to complete the course.

The **Grade System**: For each semester, Grade System as given in the table below is adopted for declaration of results.

In addition to Grade System, marks obtained in each paper shall also be announced, for the awarded of class for the Bachelor's degree courses, the cumulative performance of the candidates in the last 4-years (3rd, 4th, 5th, and 6th) will be considered, for the award of class for the master degree courses, the cumulative performance of the candidates in 2-semesters will be considered.
